




To prevent damage to your new UltraSPARC™ II 400-MHz CPU module, you must replace two CPU card cage guides *before* you install *any* new CPU module. Remove your old CPU modules from the Sun Enterprise™ 250 server. Follow the instructions in the section "How to Remove a CPU Module" in the *Sun Enterprise 250 Server Owner's Guide*. Remove both modules if necessary.

## Removing the CPU Module Card Cage Guides

- Remove both card guides installed on the left (rear panel) side of the CPU card cage.

Using a pair of pliers, squeeze the guide split posts together, and push the post until the card guide is loosened on the inside of the card cage.



**Warning** – Failure to carefully follow the installation instructions could result in permanent damage to your new UltraSPARC II 400-MHz CPU module.


## Installing the CPU Module Card Cage Guides

- Align each new card guide so that the *sloped* end is nearest to the front of the card cage, and so that the holes are opposite those in the CPU card cage assembly.



**Warning** – Make sure that the *sloped* end of each new card guide is toward the opening into which the CPU module is installed.

- Press each new card guide until it locks into place.



Follow the instructions in the *Sun Enterprise 250 Server CPU Module Guide*, to install your new UltraSPARC II 400-MHz CPU module. Install both new modules, if necessary.
