The DECserver 300 for MS-DOS® is a software package composed of the software image for the Digital DECserver 300 Terminal Server, and the software which enables a Personal Computer (AT class) to serve as a load host for the terminal server. This software package runs on Personal Computers running the MS-DOS Operating System and DECnet PCSA Client for DOS (PATHWORKS for DOS).

This product is used to downline load the DECserver 300 terminal server, with its operating image, over the server's Ethernet/802.3 connector.

Installation and Configuration

The software and image is first installed on an MS-DOS system (termed a load host). The terminal server software image is then downline-loaded from the load host.
