DESCRIPTION

Emacs provides an advanced editing system enabling multi-windowing and integration with the application development environment. In addition, a large number of automatic support facilities for the programmer are included. The Emacs product is developed by UniPress Software, and sold under Digital Equipment Corporation's terms and conditions.

Emacs is a powerful and advanced full-screen editor. It can operate on several in-core buffers in parallel. Each of these buffers can contain the contents of a source file as well as the result of an execution run. In order to look into these buffers, Emacs operates with windows. Buffers can be reviewed and changed through these windows.

A large number of support functions are available to assist programmers, including:

- undoing the last command or sequence of commands
- incremental search and replace functions
- · automatic back-up
- in-line expansion of previously defined abbreviations
- on-line Help

Emacs operates in an environment that enables the user to start jobs without leaving Emacs and to collect the output of such jobs into a buffer. The user can then examine and manipulate the contents of that buffer through a window. Since Emacs is mainly used for program development, special integration towards MAKE (the UNIX® product generation tool) is present. This enables the programmer (for example) to run a compilation (as part of MAKE) and to collect the diagnostics into a buffer.
