PRODUCT NAME: Compaq Office Server Web Interface V7.0

DESCRIPTION

The Compaq™ Office Server Web Interface V7.0 (the "Web Interface") enables users of the Internet anywhere in the world to process mail within their own personal Compaq Office Server and ALL-IN-1 File Cabinet. From a standard Web browser such as Netscape Communicator or Microsoft® Internet Explorer, the user logs on with user name and password authorization to access their personal files on the server and read, reply, forward, refile and delete messages. In addition, any document placed in a WORLD READ drawer or drawer identified as accessible from the Internet can then be accessed from the Internet without having to log on.

The Web Interface enables the inclusion of existing attachments when forwarding mail and it is possible to reply to individual attached messages in received mail. Any folder may be accessed including those in drawers on remote systems—utilizing the Distributed Sharing Option—that the user has authorization to access. Documents and messages can be downloaded to the client with automatic conversion of WPS—PLUSTM (V4.2 and later) and WordPerfect® (V4.2 and later) to HTML.

From the Web browser users may:

- Take advantage of Nested Folders to a depth of ten levels to store messages and documents.
- Create and send, read, reply and forward messages.
 Mail address lookup is performed on partial and full addresses at time of entry when creating, answering and forwarding messages. This capability extends to whatever Directory Service Office Server or ALL-IN-1 utilises.
- The Web Server manager may specify how many documents from any chosen folder are downloaded

and displayed at a time - this speeds up performance dramatically, especially with large folders such as the INBOX.

- Multiple attachments may be added to a message during creation, replying and forwarding.
- Multiple files may be imported from the desktop and added to a message during creation, replying and forwarding.
- Office Server datasets may be accessed utilising Active Server Pages. A sample application to manage the user's nicknames is included in the kit.
- Multiple refile and delete messages and documents
- Search across folders for documents and messages from a choice of selection criteria
- · List available drawers

The system manager, on a system-wide basis, has the ability to prevent the downloading of messages classed as Company Confidential and/or Personal and Private ensuring that such messages are not downloaded to a computer outside the domain of the organization.

Documents and objects of any type may be placed in the Office Server File Cabinet for immediate access from the Internet, thereby eliminating the need to produce documents in Hypertext Markup Language (HTML), saving on the cost of HTML authoring tools and the training of staff in their use.

The Web Interface uses standard Web server functionality, dynamically producing HTML page representations of the File Cabinet. If standard encryption facilities are available on the Web Server such as SSL, then the Web Interface can take advantage of them.

The Web Interface media is installed on the customer's local Web server, either within or outside of the Internet firewall, communicating over IP with any Compaq Office Server or ALL-IN-1™ V3.2 system.

OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- With Compaq Office Server Alpha and VAX™ systems V4.0A, V5.0 and V6.0 (SPD: 61.49.00 to .03)
- With ALL-IN-1 V3.2 (not prior to V3.2) Alpha and VAX systems (SPD: 27.30.10)
- · Over TCP/IP networks

For operation with ALL-IN-1 V3.2, Distributed Sharing Option (SPD: 36.97) must be licensed on at least one ALL-IN-1 system communicating with the local Internet server. This functionality is included as standard in Compaq Office Server.

One license to install the Web Interface on one Internet or intranet server is included with the CD media kit. Additional licenses must be purchased for installation on additional servers. A Product Authorization Key (PAK) is not required for installation or use of this version of the product.

All documents within the Compag Office Server and ALL-IN-1 Office Server File Cabinets can be made secure by the inherent security capabilities. However, if advantage is not taken of these facilities, access from Office Server and ALL-IN-1 to the Internet may open up the possibility for security violations. Compaq accepts no responsibility for the security of documents and messages within the File Cabinets.
